The strong horizontal line of the **hm106 'quiet bench'**, comprising beautifully crafted seating units with or without backrest, is accentuated in these simple geometric elements by the dynamic form of the underframe. The loose armrest doubles as a seat-divider if required, and a choice of three tables completes the product range.

Upholstery of cmhr foams on fsc-sourced hardwood and plywood frames can be covered in a virtually limitless choice of fabrics and leathers. Underframes are of steel finished in a pale grey epc; an optional underframe of oiled European oak is available at additional charge on all items except the 'laptop table' hm106m. Table tops are of matt-lacquered charcoal engineered wood.





Since studying furniture and product design at Nottingham Trent University and exhibiting his first designs at the Milan Salone in 2005, Magnus Long has rapidly gained recognition as one of London's most accomplished designers. Having co-founded the prolific and awardwinning design collective Viable London, he formally established his own practice in 2012 to design furniture and products that are 'positive, understandable and relevant to their audience' for both contract and domestic markets. He is an associate lecturer at Central Saint Martins University.
